TexWalk® can be removed easily and cleaning from a variety of surfaces.

Jessup recommends the following steps when removing TexWalk®:

- 1. Use a hard squeegee or putty knife and peel back a corner at a 45 degree angle.
- 2. With a continuous motion pull TexWalk® back on itself with consistent pressure.
- 3. To reduce the chances of residual adhesive residue DO NOT pull out at a 90 degree angle but instead pull at a 180 degree angle like you are unzipping from the surface.

- 5. Should a small amount of adhesive remain on the surface, take a small piece of removed material and dab the adhesive side to the residual. This will help pull the adhesive off the surface.
