This is in response to your initial Trace Laboratory Report 37870 for your "3810/3820 Safety Track and Edge Sealer", Type XI, Comp PS, product under MIL-PRF-24667C, "Coating System, Non-Skid, for Roll, Spray, or Self-Adhering Application" and subsequent test data provided in June 2014.

NAVSEA has completed its review of the above test data provided by Jessup and finds it acceptable. The data provided with your June 5, 2014 email for abrasion resistance and salt fog testing satisfies minimum performance requirements and can be used as a substitute for the performance in-service requirement. Jessup's "3810/3820 Safety Track and Edge Sealer" meets the requirements of MIL-PRF-24667C for Type XI, Comp PS. Qualification is hereby granted to "3810/3820 Safety Track and Edge Sealer" as shown in the table below.
